

## PROGRAM GUIDELINES & ELIGIBILITY

The Recycling Education and Research Foundation ("RERF") is a 501(c) (3) not-for-profit organization associated with Institute of Scrap Recycling Industries ("ISRI"). The Foundation's core mission is to sponsor projects that promote public awareness, education, research, and the advancement of recycling.

The **RERF Veteran's Stipend Program** was created to provide financial support to veteran's who are pursuing formal training in a personal development program. The funds can be used to cover expenses, such as living expenses or childcare, which are often not permitted through traditional government or financial aid programs. The stipend is \$2,500 per year and is eligible for renewal.

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

- 1. Applications must be submitted to RERF no later than October 15, 2022.
- 2. Recipients will be announced and notified on Veteran's Day, November 11, 2022.
- 3. The stipend of \$2,500 shall be paid directly to the individual.
- 4. The stipend is renewable for up to 4 years, upon request and renewal application.
- 5. The award is to aid an individual veteran. An honorable discharge from the US Armed Services is required.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

The following must be completed and returned to RERF, postmarked by October 15, 2022.

- 1. Completed application form and release agreement, signed and dated.
- 2. A copy of Form DD-214 Discharge and Separation Document (please black out your SSN)
- 3. Answers to the application essay questions.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation, signed and dated within the last 12 months.
